

MPH Course Sequence- Fall Entry; On-Campus, 18 Months

This is a course sequence for a student with both concentrations (community health and epidemiology) who plans to graduate in 18 months. This student can take one credit of practicum each 16-week semester (3 credits total) and the remaining three practicum credits in the summer between Years 1 and 2.
